Fellowship International Mission

Where does a missionary with a definite sense of call to a particular part of the world go when he cannot find a mission that shares his vision? Fellowship International Mission (FIM) was the answer for us. FIM is in the business of helping people like us answer God's call. That is why we partnered with FIM in 2007.

At that time, we were convinced that God wanted us involved in mercy based ministry in Ghana, West Africa. But the ministry we had established, West African Mercy Ministries, was in no position to be a missionary sending organization. FIM, however, had been in the business of sending missionaries around the world since the 1950's and they were willing to be the conduit through which financial support for our family is channeled (see back panel for details).

We thank God for FIM, without them, we might still be trying to get to the mission field. But because of their unique place in missions, we were able to move to Ghana in November of 2007. I invite you to check out the Website (FIM.org) for more information about this unique ministry.

West African Mercy Ministries

Our involvement with Fellowship International Mission did not require that West African Mercy Ministries (WAMM) be dissolved. Rather, becoming FIM missionaries allowed us to move to West Africa sooner, giving it a presence in Ghana. This allowed WAMM to begin to provide mercy-based ministry to the orphaned and oppressed of West Africa much sooner than would otherwise be possible.

We thank God for this unusual partnership. As a family we are supported through donations that are channeled through FIM. But WAMM continues to exist in order to help provide resources for the ministries that are established in Ghana (and God willing throughout West Africa). For instance, we intend to begin an infant home designed to provide temporary and hospice care for parentless children in Ghana. As that happens FIM will continue to be the organization through which our family's support is provided while WAMM will work hard to help in the funding of the home itself. This unique relationship currently allows WAMM to insure that 100% of pledged resources finds their way to caring for orphaned children in Ghana.

FIM-Ghana

It provides a point of convergence at which the missionaries of FIM and the resources of WAMM come together so mercy-based ministry can happen.

FIM-Ghana oversees the ministries that FIM has sent us to Ghana to develop and direct using resources provided through organizations like WAMM. Its Ghanaian board of directors help insure that we minister in a culturally sensitive and relevant manner and provides an entity that God can use to make sure the ministries will outlive any us should he delay his return that long.

We are thankful for all these organizations (even if they can be hard for our supporters to keep straight). Through resources funneled through FIM, our family's needs are met. Through resources funneled through WAMM, ministry needs are provided. And through FIM-Ghana, the work is accomplished in Ghana. Please keep all three in your prayers.
