

## Who We Hope to Be

**We want to know God experientially**, so we give ourselves to mercy ministry. Why? Because extending mercy is what it means to know God (Jer. 22:16), and knowing God is worth more than anything else in all the world (Phil. 3:8-10).

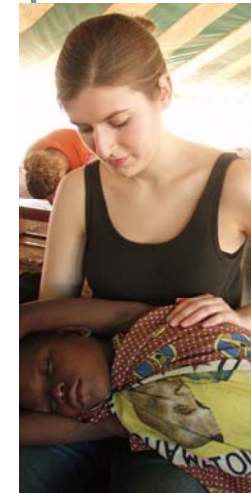

## What We Hope to Be

**A Receiving Home:** Children can come into care at any time, for any reason, and with any number of physical and emotional needs. We hope to be a ministry that can immediately accept such children into care, assess and then begin to address any needs they present.

**A Hospice Home:** Ghana has a great need for facilities that will take very ill—often terminally ill—children into care. WAMM desires to provide a home that will allow these children to experience the love of Christ as long as their little lives on earth may last.

**A Placement Home:** By design, Ghana is moving away from institutional care to a foster system of caring for orphaned and at-risk children. We hope to provide a transition for children in need of healthy families

## Where We Hope to Do It

God has a heart for orphans. *“Father of the fatherless . . . is God in his holy habitation”* (Psalm 68:5). As the *“home to over 48 million orphans”* (UNICEF report Aug., 2006),

sub-Saharan Africa must be an area for which God has great concern. We believe this is why God opened the doors for us to begin our ministry to West Africa in Accra, Ghana.

## When We Hope to Do It

From a human perspective: *There’s no time like the present.* From a heavenly perspective: *There’s no time like God’s time.* Currently we are able to take two or three children into care in our home. When God is pleased to provide the resources for a larger, dedicated facility and staff, we intend to expand this ministry.

## How We Hope to Do It

**Through Bed Sponsorships:** For \$300.00/month, you, your family, your small group, etc. can provide food, clothing, and care for an orphaned or at-risk child who is occupying one of the beds in the children’s home. Sponsors will receive pictures and a brief biography (as privacy laws allow) each time a new child fills that bed.

**Through Fund-Raising and Donations:** This may involve a one-time gift that will help secure and furnish a 10 to 15-bed infant and toddler home. Maybe you would be willing to organize a fund-raiser for the same purpose. Or perhaps you would like to give on a monthly basis to help with the operation and maintenance of a clean, healthy facility in which

children can receive loving care.

**Through Short-Term Trips or Internships:** We would also love to give you an opportunity to minister to orphaned children in a hands-on way. Whether you want to hold babies or hold a paintbrush, you are more than welcome. If we can help you know God experientially, love God actively and worship God purely through the extension of his mercy, please contact us.

## Why We Hope to Do It

This ministry is not just about who we hope to be. It is also about who we want to help you to be. We believe mercy ministry gives every believer an opportunity to know God experientially, love God actively and worship God purely. We long to be a conduit through which ordinary Christians can have their own ministries of mercy resulting in an extraordinary relationship with Jesus Christ.
